PRIVATE ACCOMMODATION

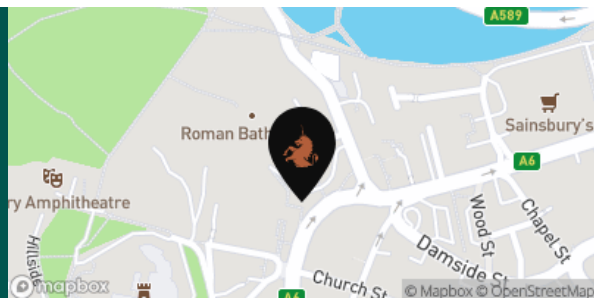
