
THE DETAIL

TRADING

The Heron is a large community pub, set in the heart of Kendal, the gateway to the Lake District. As you enter up the drive of the pub, there is a large garden and patio area festooned with outside furniture and benches. To the rear of the pub you will find a large carpark with spaces for around 20 cars. There is also a further patio area to the rear of the pub, with further benches for people to enjoy a drink in the warmer months. As you enter the front of the pub, the pub opens up to be a large open planned trading area. to the left of the pub there is the darts board and pool table. To the right of the pub there is the relaxing area with a large log burner. The bar is situated just off centre and is of a good size, with a large range of Robinsons cask, kegs and cider, as well a large array of spirits and wines. To the rear of the pub there is a large restaurant/bar area which is a large and light airy space, with plenty of chairs and tables. The kitchen is of a large size and is well equipped, a perfect space to offer homemade pub food.

PRIVATE

There is an extremely large three bedroom, well presented flat found on the first floor of the pub. The flat consists of a bathroom, lounge and kitchen.
