Each room accommodates approximately 16 covers, with a warm, inviting feel throughout. The bar serves a full range of Robinsons cask and keg ales, wines, spirits, and a few popular cocktails. The kitchen is modern and fully equipped to a high spec, perfect for delivering a premium food offer. A spacious streamside beer garden with seating for around 42 guests completes the offer, providing scenic views across Brigsteer.
