PRIVATE ACCOMMODATION

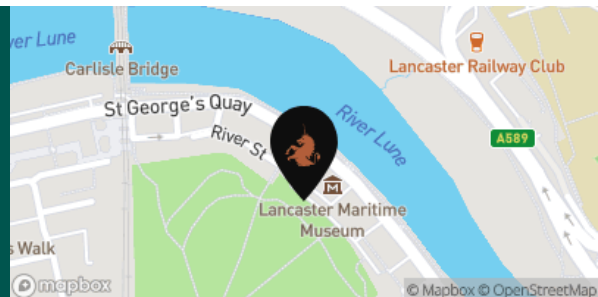
